## **READ WORKS**

**(Year 7 and Year 8)**

Dear Parents,

As part of our curriculum this year, our year 7 and 8 will be using the online platform ReadWorks, ([www.readworks.org](http://www.readworks.org)) to support and enhance their pleasure for reading and to improve their comprehension skills. ReadWorks provides our students with high quality and engaging nonfiction and literary texts, e-books, question sets, vocabulary practice, and other supports through the platform.

### **Here's how it works:**

The English teacher has set up an account for the class and invited your child to join the class using a unique class code. The class code is the login credential for the students. Students have been given a default password which can be changed when they login.

- For year 7 & 8 classes, your child will only have an access to ReadWorks through the account that is linked to specific class account. Your child will not have a separate, personal account on ReadWorks.
- The English teacher provides your child with assignments through ReadWorks. Assignments will include reading nonfiction and literary articles, learning vocabulary, answering multiple choice and written response questions, and engaging with other Readworks content and curriculum as assigned by the English teacher.
- The teacher and the student can view his or her assignments and results.
- Your child is expected to act responsibly and honestly when using ReadWorks, engaging with ReadWorks content, and completing assignments on the ReadWorks website.
- ReadWorks account also has a library that is rich with bodies of fiction, non-fiction and e-books of different genre which can be read for improving reading skills and for pleasure. We encourage your child to read for at least 30 minutes a day.
- ReadWorks online reading platform provides a safe and secure online reading experience for students.

We are excited to use ReadWorks and look forward in using the platform to develop their pleasure for reading and their comprehension skills.
