The end of term 2 summative assessments for years 2 to 8 will commence from March 11th – 22nd, 2024. While these assessments are important as they are a reinforcement of all the learning that has happened through the term, please note these are not the only assessments. The students are assessed through other ongoing formative assessments during the term as well so we should encourage our students to take these assessments in their stride and not feel anxious.

We will have teachers revising content, offering assertive mentoring as necessary for students that need it and ensuring that students have the best chance to succeed.

Please note the important points:

- Term End assessments add major weightage to the term-end report card.
- No retests will be given for any assessments.
- Late arrivals for the exams are not allowed and no extra time will be given for the same.
- Absenteeism other than medical leaves will be graded as U.

Please make sure that your child attends all assessments without fail.

We will make sure that our students are supported to the best possible degree. **We are facilitating early dispersal for all students at 12 pm during the assessment days** so that children get enough time to get back home, rest and prepare for their next assessments.

Our students' mental health and well-being are important so, as parents, please ensure that the learning environment at home is conducive to retention. We seek your support in encouraging students to take term end assessment as enjoyable and fulfilling experience.


