



## **NAP General Circular**

**(FS to Year 10)**

Dear Parents,

Greetings from **The Apple International Community School**.

In line with the UAE National Agenda and the guidelines from the KHDA and MOE, our school will continue administering a series of standardized assessments, in addition to our internal school-based assessments during this academic year. These assessments provide valuable insights into students' abilities and progress, benchmarked against international standards, and support their academic growth.

### **National Agenda Parameter (NAP) Assessments in AY 2025 -26 include:**

- CAT4 (Cognitive Abilities Test): Measures reasoning ability and learning potential (Year 3-10) : **September 2025**
- NGRT (New Group Reading Test): Assesses reading and comprehension skills. (Year 2-10) : **October 2025 and April 2026**
- PASS (Pupil's Attitude Towards School and Studies)-Year 4-10 : **October 2025**
- ABT (Arabic Benchmark Test): Evaluates Arabic language proficiency. -(Year 4-10) : **November 2025 and April-May 2026**
- GL Progress Tests (English, Mathematics, Science): Track students' attainment and progress over time. (FS2-Year 10) : **May-June 2026**
- PIRLS(Progress in International Reading Literacy Study) an international assessment of reading comprehension in Year 5 students that occurs every five years. (**Mar-April 2026 tentatively**)

### **Others :-**

- TIMSS (Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study): An international benchmark in Mathematics and Science (Year 5/9)-Conducted once in 4 years and will be conducted in AY 2026-27.
- PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment): Measures skills in reading, mathematics, and science for 15-year-olds- Conducted once in 3 years and will be conducted in AY 2027-28

### **Purpose of these assessments:**

- To provide reliable data on student performance.
- To inform teaching strategies and enhance learning outcomes.
- To contribute to the UAE's achievement of the National Agenda 2030 goals.



**Key Points for Parents:**

- These assessments are not used for grading or promotion.
- They help identify strengths and areas of improvement.
- Your support in ensuring your child is well-rested, prepared, and present during test days is crucial.

We will share individual student reports and feedback once results are available. Thank you for your continued cooperation in supporting our students' success.
