4. Vice Head Girl (Year 9/10)

House Council:

1. House Captain for each house (Girl/Boy)
2. Vice House Captain (Girl/Boy)
3. Sports Captain (Boy/Girl)

Positions that will be nominated by Teachers:

1. Ancillary council: Wellbeing Champion, Innovation Champion, Cultural Secretary, Reading Champion, Happiness Champion, Eco Warrior, Editor -in chief, Health and safety ambassadors, Punctuality & Uniform Ambassadors

2. Class Council: Prefects

3. Junior Sports Captain (Boy/Girl) – Year 6

- Candidate Speeches: **Monday 29th September 2025** (Core Council nominees only)
- Panel discussion of shortlisted candidates: **Tuesday 30th September 2025**
- Election of the core council members: **Wednesday 1st October 2025**
- Final Stage: Principal's interview with shortlisted candidates
- Result Declaration

Investiture ceremony:

➤ Senior council KS3 & KS4	: Wednesday 8 th October 2025
➤ Junior council KS2, Council of KS1, Council of FS	: Friday 10 th October 2025



Voting Process:

- The short-listed **core council members** will be elected through a secret ballot by students and teachers. This gives student exposure to the voting rights.
- All shortlisted candidates for all councils will have interview with the panel of School leaders.
- The House council members, ancillary council members and class prefects will be selected/elected by teachers.
