UAE Flag Day
(FS & Year 10)

Dear Parents,

Greetings from **Apple International Community School!**

We are delighted to inform you that our school will be celebrating **UAE Flag Day** with great pride and enthusiasm. The event will take place on **3rd of November**, and a range of engaging activities have been planned across all year levels to instill national pride and unity among our students.

Please find below the schedule and materials required from students for the celebration:

Flag Day Flow & Activities

Timing: 7:45 – 9:00 AM

FS will have class-based Flag Day activities

Key stages:

Activity 1:

Years 1–4: creating a mural with *bottle Caps* – Students to bring **bottle caps of UAE colors from home**

- **Year 1:** black
- **Year 2:** white
- **Year 3:** green
- **Year 4:** Red

Activity 2:

Years 6–10 (Selected Students) - Students prepare short tech-based presentations or apps about “UAE Technological Progress.” Presentations may include simple coding, robotics, or multimedia. ICT Lab Activity

Activity 3:

Years 6–7 (Selected Students) – 4 teams girls & 4 teams boys House Wise: **THEME: “COOKING WITHOUT FIRE- THE FLAVOURS OF THE FLAG”**

Venue: Badminton court: *(All participants must bring aprons, head caps, hand gloves, napkins, mixing bowls, spoons, and tissues.)*

- **Year 6 Girls (Red Dish):** Boiled beetroot, tahini sauce, lemon, olive oil, salt, paper plates, and spoons
- **Year 6 Boys (Green Dish):** Lettuce, cucumber, mint, parsley, lemon, salt, pepper dressing, paper cups
- **Year 7 Girls (White Dish):** Yogurt, mint, cucumber, salt, cumin powder, ice-cream cups with small spoons
- **Year 7 Boys (Black Dish):** Dates, tahini, oats, sesame seeds, condensed milk, honey, small paper plates and spoons.

Presentation & Decoration Plan:

- Each Year level will have a **table decorated in their assigned flag colour** (red, green, white, or black).
- Use **balloons, ribbons, or cloth** in matching colours.



- Display a **mini-UAE flag** and a **name card of the dish** on each table.
- When all tables are arranged together, they should visually form the **UAE national flag**.

Judging / Appreciation Criteria:

1. **Creativity & Presentation** – Use of flag colour and Emirati touch
2. **Taste & Texture** – Fresh, balanced flavours
3. **Teamwork** – Equal participation of all members
4. **Hygiene & Safety** – Clean and organized preparation
5. **Patriotic Spirit** – Reflection of UAE pride in the setup

Activity 4:

Arabic Poem Recitation (Years 3–10 Arabs) Venue: Arabic Room.

Teachers will share the poems links on Teams for each year group – Arabic Channel. Students should memorize and recite the poem.
