**Participant Divisions**

- Junior Division: Ages 10 – 14 Years
- Senior Division: Ages 15 – 19 Years

**General Eligibility**

- Individual or Team participation (up to 3 students)
- Drama category allows up to 5 members
- Multi-school teams are permitted
- One category per student
- One team per student
- Projects must align with UN Sustainable Development Goals (excluding STEM Lesson & Robotics)
- Projects must be original work
- English communication required (simple English acceptable)
- Adult supervisor (20+) required (Maximum 6 students per supervisor)
- Highest standards of academic integrity required. Cheating, plagiarism, or data falsification will result in disqualification.

- Project Submission Deadline: 1 March 2026
- Science Categories:
- Submit abstract initially
- Full research paper and supporting documents may be uploaded later
- Non-Scientific Categories:
- Written description required at submission
- Supporting materials may be uploaded later

### **Participation Format (On-Site – London, UK)**

- Live Presentation and Q&A with judges
- Display Board maximum size: 91cm (H) x 122cm (W)
- Mandatory attendance at Opening Ceremony (Oxford), Exhibition Day, Award **Ceremony, and London excursions**
- Strictly Prohibited: Live animals, microbial cultures, hazardous chemicals, water, open flames, sharp objects, human or animal food

- Visiting Scholar: £900 + £35 Registration Fee (For students arranging their own accommodation)
