



Term 2 Assessment updates

(FS to Year 10)

Dear Parents,

Greetings from **The Apple International Community School**.

As previously informed, and in line with the directive issued by the **KHDA**, the Spring Break has been preponed and will now take place from **Monday, 9 March 2026 to Sunday, 22 March 2026**, with classes resuming on **Monday, 23 March 2026 on site as of now**.

Assessment Arrangements

Please note that Term 2 assessments for Year 2 - 10 (that were scheduled from 2nd March to 13th March) **stand cancelled.**

To ensure continuity in learning and academic readiness for the next academic year, the following approach will be adopted:

1) Assessment Structure

- Key concepts taught in Term 2 but not assessed yet due to ongoing situation will be assessed during the Term 3 Interim / Periodic Assessments along with some portions of term 3 syllabus.

2) Report Card Preparation – Year 2 to 10

For the preparation of Term 2 Report Cards, the following will apply:

- The average marks obtained in the Interim unit test / Formative Assessments conducted during Term 2 will be used for the preparation of the report cards.
- Details regarding the Report Card release date and the Online/On Site Parent–Teacher Meeting (PTM) will be communicated to parents at a later stage.
- FS and Year 1 reports will be prepared based on the continuous provisions as usual.

3) Submission of Projects under Project Based Learning

- Submissions of Project Based Learning will happen after the Spring Break and students will be given some more time to submit their projects and assignments owing to current circumstances and their score will also be added in the term 3 report.

4) Subject specific tasks and assignments during Spring break time

- All subject heads will be providing a few subject related tasks for students to complete and submit on the specific deadlines through MS Teams during Spring break. This is important in order to address the gaps in students' learning. Kindly keep a watch on the same and keep visiting MS Team channels.

As families observe the upcoming break, we encourage parents to spend meaningful and quality time with their children during the Spring and Eid holidays, supporting their wellbeing and strengthening family bonds.
